## Musket

### Medium

Walnut, steel, brass, iron

### Description

A British-made Short Land musket, with a walnut stock, brass butt plate, steel smooth bore barrel, brass trigger and trigger guard, and original steel ramrod with original brass ramrod brackets. The musket has been converted to a percussion cap firing mechanism, with the original steel plate fitted with a large steel percussion hammer with foliate engraving on the side. The original screw holes for the frizzen, flash pan, and cock assembly can be seen on either side of the percussion hammer. The number "550" is engraved on the top of the wrap panel portion of the butt plate, and "LONDON" can be seen faintly on the top of the barrel near the firing mechanism, both appearing as original markings.
