Description

A landscape depiction from the northeast of the Morford & Spinning store on the southwest corner of Broad and Front

Streets in Red Bank, NJ. The building is a long, single story structure with a second floor attic and black roof. Double doors are centered on the gable end facing Broad Street, flanked by large display windows. A second entrance is located at the Broad Street end of the north elevation. A columned wood-floored porch extends across the front of the building, and wraps around to the north entrance. It is surmounted by a large sign that reads "MORFORD & SPINNING." A small chimney is centered on the ridge of the roof. Eight men, women and a child are positioned around the building. A carriage drawn by two horses passes in front of the store, while an empty horse-drawn wagon approaches from the right. The latter is followed by a dog.
