Description

View of a church building with two entrances on the gable end and four pointed Gothic arch windows along the side elevation. An octagonal cupola with a half-dome roof and weather vane sits on the west gable. A chimney appears at a mid point on the ridge line. The wood shingled

structure is painted red, with light cream trim. It sits behind a picket fence and several trees which are in full leaf. The sky is left in the natural iridescence of the shell, although the artist did include a flock of birds in flight above the cupola.
