Description

Tobacco jar, with cylindrical body and shallow molded band around neck and base. Pair of molded lion's heads at left and right sides, glazed blue. Thick plain neck. Jar ornamented with elaborate blue glazed decoration on front, consisting of central open astragal panel with the inscription "3 RAPPE DE ST OMER." Panel flanked by pair of Native Americans, holding pipes and standing in front of bundles of tobacco leaves. Panel topped with elaborate palmetto and stylized foliate scrolling. Along bottom of panel, there is a border panel of stylized floral and foliate motifs. Separate lid of molded brass, in stepped cone
