### Description

An early fall view looking east from near the present high ground location of Eastpointe condominiums toward Highlands showing much open farmland in the middle

distance. The edge of the Highlands of Navesink appears on the right with the village of Highlands at its foot and on the lower slope. Sandy Hook Bay appears in the distance, with Sandy Hook and the Atlantic Ocean beyond. Small and large sailing vessels appear on the water, with a steamboat in the bay on the left. A red and white striped navigational range light appears on the shoreline on the extreme left. The farmstead in the left middle distance features a Dutch barn. The day was clear with a bright blue sky and puffy white clouds. The painting is in its original silver-gilt frame enhanced with bands of cast plaster ornament. A coat of gold radiator paint has been applied to it. Losses to the plaster ornament in the lower right.
