An abstract night time depiction of the Monmouth County Court House erected in 1731. The two story, gambrel roofed structure is situation in the lower right hand corner. It has a three bay facade, two bay end gable, shingles with rounded butts, and an exaggerated cupola with a domed roof on the center line of the roof ridge. Three large hills appear to the left of the court house, with bare trees in the foreground. A large half moon rises above the hills behind the court house.
