Description

Three-quarter view of a story and a half dwelling in ruinous condition. It features round butt shingles, two

chimneys, a one story wing to the right with one chimney, and two windows in the left gable end. The left rear corner post has been removed with the second floor in that area collapsing, and shingles have been ripped off from the lower courses on the gable end. Other areas of roof and wall shingles are also missing. A carriage drawn by a single horse is arriving in the lower right corner, with a male in the driver's seat and a woman and child in the carriage behind him. Two males with hats are examining the structure right of center, while a man in a top hat is gesturing toward the structure left of center accompanied by a female carrying a parasol and a young female child. A male wearing a top hat stands in the left second floor window of the gable end.
