



Continuous Bow Windsor Arm Chair

Description

The brace-back style maple frame includes a curved and shaped continuous rail that ends in flat scroll arm rest terminals, thirteen taper turned spindles, and two heavier baluster turned arm supports. Two taper turned spindles flare from the small brace tab at the rear of the seat and fit into the underside of the continuous back. The solid saddle seat rests atop four baluster turned and splayed legs braced with a bulbous turned "H" shaped stretcher assembly. Remnants of the chair's original black paint remain.
