Birdseye and striped maple, maple veneer, sweet gum, and hard pine

Description

An Empire style chest of drawers that has a plain rectangular top with squared edges, and paneled sides. A

projecting top tier of two drawers with pulvinated or convexly curved fronts have pairs of small circular stamped brass pulls. Three full-width graduated drawers below also have pairs of circular stamped brass pulls. The three full drawers, set back into the case, are flanked by turned columns atop a stepped base and four turned compound ball feet. The drawer fronts and dividers have been finished with highly figured birdseye maple veneer. A repair to the veneer appears on the upper edge of the second drawer left of center.
