

# Child's High Chair

## **Primary Maker**

#### Medium

Maple, and ash

## Description

The rear posts of this child's rush bottom high chair flare outward slightly above the seat. They have also been flattened or "rabbit eared" above a ring turning below the seat. Two graduated rectangular slats form the back. The front posts also have a ring turning at their mid point, and are tapered above the seat where they become supports for the turned arms. Four dowel turned stretchers brace the lower legs. The chair retains its original dark finish, stenciled yellow decoration, and woven rush seat. A step below the seat has been removed.
