

Fiddleback Arm Chair

Medium

Maple, ash

Description

An oversized arm chair with a shaped crest rail, the bottom edge of which curves into the splat. The latter is attached to a simple rectangular shoe. Turned rear posts with flattened balls fit into the left and right ends of the crest rail and are pegged into place. Shaped arms end in flattened vertical scrolls, and are supported by baluster turnings that are an extension of the front posts. These turned front posts with flattened balls terminate in small ball feet. All four posts have been ended out. The chair features an unusual pair of bulbous turned front stretchers. The remainder of the frame consists of two pairs of dowel-turned side stretchers, and a single rear stretcher. The woven rush seat has been replaced.
