High Back Windsor Arm Chair

Medium

Ash and maple, with tulip poplar seat and oak arm terminals

Description

The reddish-brown painted ash and maple Windsor arm chair features a serpentine crest rail ending in scrolled ears, with seven plain turned spindles fitting into a curved medial rail which extends to form arms ending in carved oak scroll knuckles. Four short plain turned spindles run from the medial rail to the seat, along with a pair of baluster turned arm supports. The oval seat rests upon four baluster turned and splayed legs braced with an "H" style, bulbous turned stretcher assembly. The arms originally were plain ended as the outer scrolled oak arm terminals were added later, probably in the nineteenth century.
